I refer to correspondence dated 09 June 2023 requesting to waive the requirement for a Biodiversity Development Assessment Report (BDAR) to be lodged with the development application for the Smithfield Battery Energy Storage System (SSD-59325460).

The Department has consulted with the Biodiversity and Conservation Division (BCD) and has reviewed the information provided in the BDAR waiver application and has determined that the proposed development is not likely to have a significant impact on biodiversity values. The application, therefore, does not need to be accompanied by a BDAR. A copy of BCD's advice is attached.

Accordingly, as delegate for the Planning Secretary, I have determined that a waiver under section 7.9 of the Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016 is granted for the proposed development.
